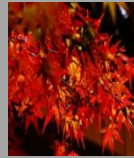


Can you create a 'Sensory Touch Board' with different textures on? For example, smooth, bumpy, hard, soft, furry, rough, scratchy etc.



Can you go on a '5 Senses Autumnal Walk'? What can you see? What can you hear? What can you smell? What can you feel? What can you taste?



Can you pick a sound of your choice and go on a Phonics hunt? Can you draw a picture or take a photo of the things you find? Can you sound out and write the words using your Phonics? Some sounds you might like to choose from – ch, sh, th.



Can you show me your number bonds to 10? Maybe you could use your toys at home and take photos? 5 red cars and 5 blue cars, etc.



Can you create a dance to a famous song? Perhaps you can teach your friends in the playground!



Can you get creative and make your own superhero out of junk modelling? Think about how you might stick it together!



Think about 5 things you have done today. Can you draw a picture of each one or perhaps take a photo? Can you place them in order of when they happened?



Draw your own supervillain lair. Where would they live? What would they drive? Label it with the sounds you know!



Draw an evil supervillain. What superpowers would they have? Draw a picture and label it!



Can you look in the mirror and then draw or paint a self-portrait? Think carefully about shape, colour and size.



Make a poster to encourage people to recycle their rubbish properly!



Go on your own material hunt! What materials can you find around your house? Glass, wood, metal, plastic? Draw and label the objects you find!



This term we are learning about 'Belonging'. Can you create a paperchain to show who is in your family?



Design your own superhero. What superpowers would they have? Draw a picture and label it!



This term we are learning about our 5 senses. Can you try 5 different types of fruit and describe how each one looks, feels and tastes? Remember full stops and capital letters!
