

PERFORMANCE TABLES (NATIONAL, EAST SUSSEX AND CHANTRY RESULTS)

What the levels mean:-

The results show achievement against the levels on the National Curriculum scale.

- An average 7 year old is expected to achieve level 2.
- Pupils who achieve level 3 are performing better than an average 7 year old
- An average 11 year old is expected to achieve level 4
- Pupils who achieve level 5 are performing better than an average 11 year old
- Pupils who achieve level 6 are performing considerably above the average 11 year old

Interpreting the percentages:-

Parents will find a picture of how well we are doing if the actual individual results are compared with other East Sussex groups and with national figures.

Developing on quality:-

The Head, Staff and Governors have analysed results and as with all schools identified areas for development/improvement and % targets have been set. At Chantry we are always striving to develop and improve the quality of education for all children. We analyse our results each year and address our development areas as part of our School Development Plan.
