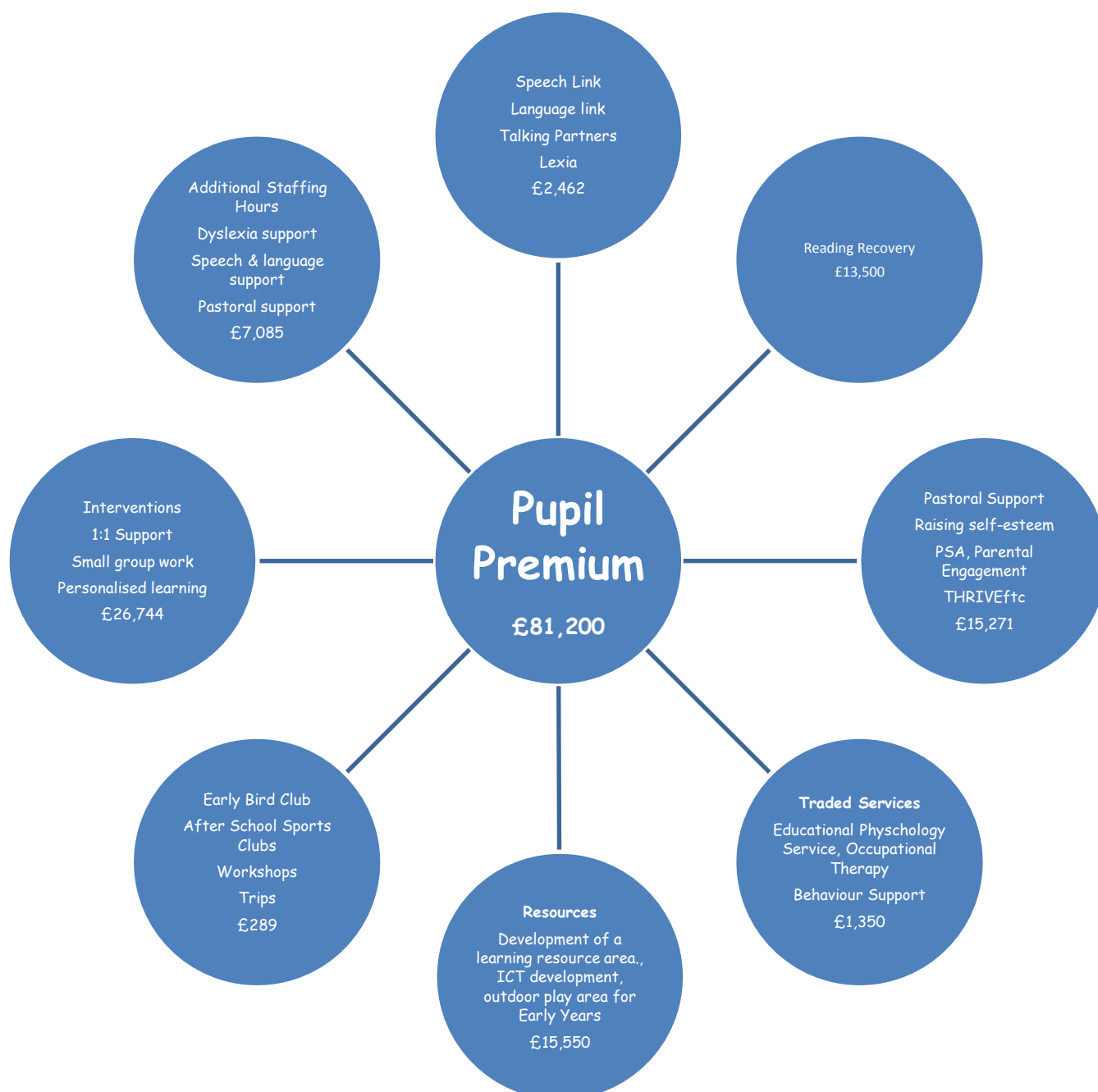

Pupil Premium

Pupil Premium Funding is money given to schools from the Government to support the progress of pupils vulnerable to under-achievement as identified by the Government, such as:-

- Children entitled to Free School Meals,
- Looked After Children,
- Children of Armed Service Personnel.

The amount received for the financial year 2014- 15 was £81,200. The school and governing body spent these funds in the following way:

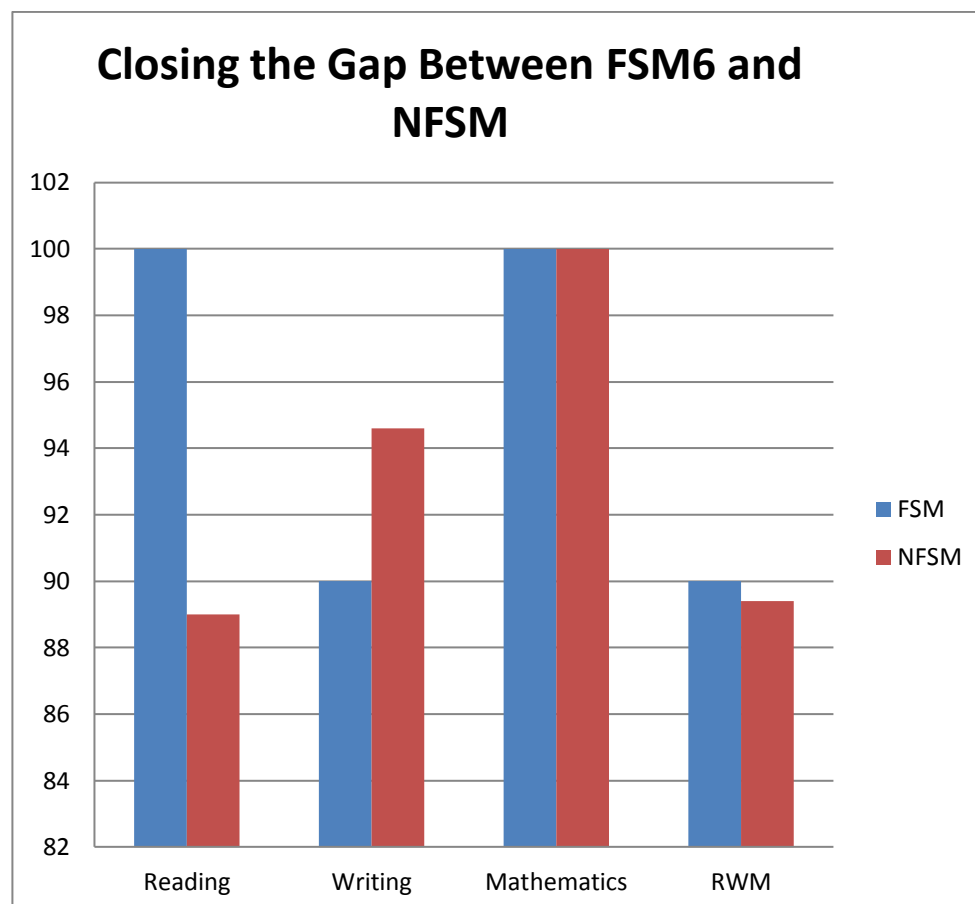
Summary:

In Reading 100% of FSM pupils achieved Level 4 while 89.4% of NFSM pupils achieved Level 4.

In Writing 90% of FSM pupils achieved Level 4 while 94.6% of NFSM pupils achieved Level 4.

In Maths 100% of FSM pupils achieved Level 4 while 100% of NFSM pupils achieved Level 4.

In Reading, Writing and Maths combined, 90% of FSM pupils achieved Level 4 while 89.4% of NFSM pupils achieved Level 4.

Feed forward / Actions:

- Awareness raised for all teachers during pupil progress meetings.

Planned spend for 2015/16 Pupil Premium Grant
