Timetable

A typical day may look like this:

8.45am - 9am Phonics	Access the phonics challenge set on Seesaw. More phonics activities can be found on https://www.teachyourmonstertoread.com/u/1108712
9:00am -10.30am	Independent Learning. Play alongside your child and notice if any natural topics arise. To encourage a child to think about their learning and to develop their language skills, the following open ended questions can be asked: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How are these the same? • How are they different? • Why is this here? • What else could work for that? • Can you see anything that could help us to do that? • What else do we need to make this?
10.30am - 11am	Break and a healthy snack. Daily reading. Online books can be accessed on https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/for-home/find-a-book/library-page/
11am – 11.20am Writing	Follow Seesaw instructions set by teachers. Remember to encourage your child to form their letters correctly, allow them to hold the pencil in the way that is most comfortable for them.
12noon - 1pm	Lunch
1-1.15pm Maths	Follow Seesaw instructions set by teachers. Remember to encourage your child to form their numbers correctly. Daily counting practise will be beneficial. More maths activities can be accessed on https://numbots.com/
2pm Home learning menu	Select one of the tasks from your Home Learning grid to complete each week.
