#### Timetable

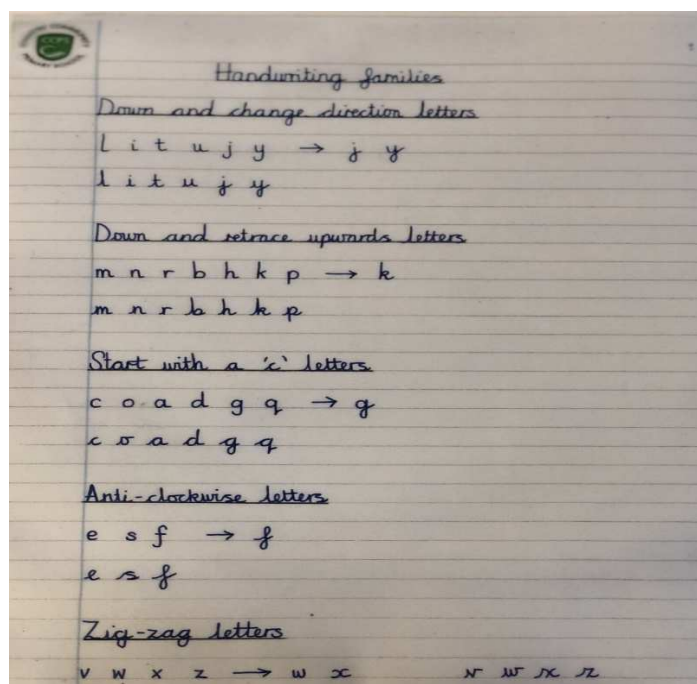
A typical day may look like this:

8.45am - 9am Let's get active!	Let's get active! Go Noodle/Cosmic Yoga/Just Dance/Joe Wicks
9am – 9:30am Phonics	Complete Phonics lesson/activities set on Seesaw by teachers.  Online Phonics games... <a href="https://www.phonicsbloom.com/">https://www.phonicsbloom.com/</a> <a href="https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/">https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/</a>
9:30am - 10am Reading	One to one reading: Can your child read you their reading book? You could challenge them to look for a specific word on each page and remember to discuss what happens etc. There are lots of free online books here too... <a href="https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/for-home/find-a-book/library-page">https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/for-home/find-a-book/library-page</a> Challenge your child. Ask your child to practise writing a key word from the book or draw their favourite part of the story etc.
10am 10.15 Handwriting	Refer to the handwriting policy below and use to practise. Pick a set of letters to practise, for example, the down and change direction letters. Focus on the starting point of each letter and the similar patterns.
10.15-- 10.45am English	Complete the English task set on Seesaw by teachers. Remember to ask your child to complete their English task on paper at home and then upload a photo of it to go on Seesaw. It's important that your child still has the opportunity to put pencil to paper.
10.45am - 11am Break & snack	Break and healthy snack
11am – 11:15am Warm-up Maths Games	Numbots: <a href="https://numbots.com/">https://numbots.com/</a> Mathletics: <a href="https://www.mathletics.com/uk/">https://www.mathletics.com/uk/</a>
11:15am - 12 noon Maths	Complete Maths lesson/activities set on Seesaw by teachers. More maths activities can be found by following this link: <a href="https://classroom.thenational.academy/year-groups">https://classroom.thenational.academy/year-groups</a>
12noon - 1pm	Lunch. Try and get outside for some fresh air too!

1.00-1.15 Share a Story	Share a story together: Can you read a story to your child? Ask them about the character's feelings/events that happen in the story.
1.15pm – 1.45pm Other Subjects (Science/Geography/ Art/History etc)	Look on Seesaw for today's afternoon subject. Complete the activity.
1.45-2.15 PE	Do some PE activities together. Make up some challenges and try and beat your scores each day.
2.15pm - 3pm Home Learning Menu/BBC Bitesize	Select one of the tasks from your Home Learning grid to complete each week.
