Uniform

A gentle reminder that children need to wear full school uniform, including black shoes in school. KS2 can come into school wearing their kit on their P.E. days: green shorts, a plain white t-shirt, trainers and a school jumper. Plain dark joggers can also be worn for P.E. on colder days.

Children in Years R - 3 can bring book bags into school. From year 4, children may bring a small flat bag (that can be folded away when they get to school) with their water bottle and reading book in. We ask that children don't bring in larger bags, toys or any additional items as they are not needed in school and are difficult to store in the classroom.

Please remember that make-up, jewellery (except small stud earrings) and nail varnish are not part of our uniform and children will be asked to remove these items when at school.
