## IMPORTANT SCHOOL DINNER FUNDING

I am just writing to remind you that we receive school funding which is based on the number of children that are registered for free school meals, This funding is called Pupil Premium, we use this in many ways in school e.g. reading recovery, booster classes, additional resources, further details of which can be found on our website. To give you an idea of the importance of this funding we received £69,302 last year.

The Government funding we receive is calculated on several 'Census Days' during the year, the next one is on 5<sup>th</sup> October 2017. We would therefore like to encourage children to have a lunch on this day. There is a special menu which is being sent out.

If you think you may be entitled to register for Free School Meals please come into the school office and speak to Mrs Roadway or Mrs Vaughan in confidence. The process is very simple and only involves filling out one form. Entitlement is based on the following criteria:-

- Income Support
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA)
- Employment & Support Allowance (income related)
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, but who are not entitled to a Working Tax Credit and whose annual income (as assessed by the Inland Revenue) does not exceed £16,190
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Families in receipt of Working Tax Credit will not be entitled to receive free school meals
- Universal Credit
