## Year 4 Swimming

22<sup>nd</sup> July 2022

We are pleased to advise that we have managed to secure a swimming session for year 4 for terms 1 & 2 in September.

The swimming sessions will take place at Battle Abbey Pool. The course will run for 16 weeks on Monday mornings, beginning Monday 12<sup>th</sup> September – Monday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2023. The class will be split into 2 groups with 15 children swimming for an hour for 8 weeks then the next group will swim for the next 8 weeks. Mrs Smith will advise you which group your child will be in and when they will be swimming.

The children will be swimming between 11am – 12noon, returning to school in time to eat their lunch.

The cost of the Pool and the swimming teachers will be covered by the school, we are however, asking for a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the transport. For the 8 week period, that your child will be swimming, we are asking you for a voluntary contribution of just £2.50 per week, £20.00 in total. We do hope you will be able to support us in running this activity. This swimming course will benefit all children regardless of their swimming ability.

Please complete the consent/medical form and payment via parentpay by Monday 5<sup>th</sup> September. Ensure detailed information of any medical condition is included, as we need to pass this information to Battle Abbey Pool.

We just have a few practicalities to pass on regarding this activity:-

- Please could children (particularly those with long hair) wear swimming hats, we do have these available but the children may wish to bring their own.
- No body lotion/shower gel/anti-perspirant should be brought. There is very little time for the children to shower and change.
