School will restart on **Thursday 2nd September.** We will be keeping the staggered start, so start /finish times will be:

Children will need to wear full school uniform (including black shoes) when they return. Reception and KS1 will need to bring a P.E. kit into school. KS2 can continue to come into school wearing their kit on P.E. days. KS2 class teachers will let you know which days your child has P.E. at the start of next term.

Just a reminder that children can bring book bags into school up until year 4. From year 4, children may bring a small flat bag (that can be folded away when they get to school) with their water bottle and reading book in. We ask that children don't bring in toys or any additional items as they are not needed in school.

I hope that you all have a relaxing summer and enjoy the opportunity to get out and about now that Covid restrictions have eased. Stay safe, and I look forward to seeing years 1-5 back in September.
