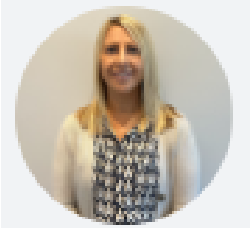

Learning from last term...

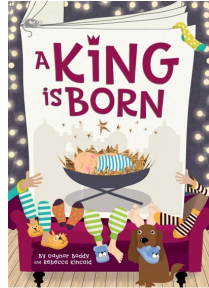
Here is a few proud moments from last term!
