



Overview of Our Learning

Year R: Term 6

'At the seaside'





English

Writing: We will be focusing on transcription (spelling and handwriting) and composition (articulating ideas and constructing them through writing). We will focus on different texts such as 'Billy's Bucket' and 'Commotion in the Ocean'. Children will be encouraged to write sentences during their independent learning. The children will also work in groups to think of their own sentences and then write them using a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop. Children will apply their phonic knowledge as they write full sentences.







Focus texts:

Reading: We will be continuing to decode new words using the strategies we have been taught. Children will begin to read CCVC words independently. Staff will support children 1:1 and in small groups to help quickly identify letter sounds and blend these sounds to read words. Children will also start to blend words more

quickly and start to recognise words by sight.

Communication and Language

Children will use talk to organise, sequence and clarify thinking, ideas, feelings and events. The children will share facts about sea creatures and retell stories such as Billy's Bucket.

Children will listen to and talk about selected non-fiction texts to develop a deep familiarity with new knowledge and vocabulary.

Personal Social and Emotional Development

Daily counting and early maths activities will support the children in developing their confidence with number.

Staff will support the children 1:1 and in small groups as they practice and consolidate their mathematical skills.

Understanding the world

The children will be discussing their knowledge of their local environment and how Bexhill has a seaside. The children will describe what they will find at the beach and the children will start to create their own maps.

The children will look at the seaside town of Bexhill now but they will also compare it to how Bexhill seaside town was in the past. The children will also compare seaside towns around the world.



Expressive arts and design

Children will safely use and explore with a variety of materials, tools and techniques used for shape, colour and design.

We will be exploring bubble painting, printing and sea creature sketches.

The children will continue to learn new songs each week that are linked to our stories. The children are then encouraged to perform their songs and make up their own songs.

The children will be using the ipad to take photos and videos of their own creations. The children will also use educational apps on the ipad.
